Death ONLY entered the world when Adam sinned (it was only after the perfect creation was spoiled that some animals, like T-Rex, became carnivores). "...sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin... "(Romans 5:12). Sadly, when Adam sinned, he lost his close friendship with God. God's perfect creation was spoiled by sin and death - and this is the whole *regson* why Jesus came to die for our sins and be raised from the dead! We all inherit Adam's sin nature, and are under God's judgment but instead of judging US for our sins, God our punishment upon himself! "But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8). So if we repent of our sins and trust in Jesus, God will forgive us! Instead of being under judgment "in Adam" we can find acceptance with God "in Christ"! And one day soon, God will make everything like it was in the beginning...


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Discover the truth about these awesome animals

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But the truth is, dinosaurs were only re-discovered in 1822. The first person to discover dinosaurs was Adam, in the Garden of Eden. In the beginning, on the 6th day of creation, God created "all" the land animals as well as Adam and Eve (Genesis 1:24-25) – and "all" must have included dinosaurs!

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
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But didn't dinosaurs live millions of years before man? No! Only people who have a faith called "evolution" say that, but there's no proof. Evolutionists thought the fish *Coelacanth* was a "prehistoric" kind of "dinosaur fish" living 340 million years ago... until one was caught in 1939! You see, evolution is NOT a science – it's just a belief, or faith, about the past.

So is there any real evidence that dinosaurs lived together with man? Yes! In the Bible a giant plant-eating creature is described, whose "tail sways like a cedar" (Job 40:15-24). No animal today has a tail as big as a cedar tree – this animal sounds like an Apatosaurus or Brachiosaurus. Another dinosaur is described in Job 41:1-34. And there are many other accounts from all over the world...

A 4,000-year-old Sumerian account describes a huge dragon; Alexander the Great found Indians worshiping huge cave-dwelling reptiles; China is full of "dragon" legends; the English account of "St George and the dragon"; a 10th century Irish account of a creature resembling a *Stegosaurus*; the 16th century English text *Historia Animalium* lists several animals resembling dinosaurs as still being alive at the time; an Italian account dated

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So what happened to the dinosaurs? It's no mystery. They simply died out, like so many other species of animals. Many were unable to survive the harsh conditions after Noah's Flood (Genesis 8) and the Ice Age (Job 37:9-10; 38:22-30). Animals became afraid of man (Genesis 9:1-3) and many species have since been hunted to extinction.

So, dinosaurs did not live millions of years before man. Jesus said Adam and Eve were created "at the beginning of creation" (Mark 10:6), so they must have lived together with dinosaurs. This wasn't a problem either, because dinosaurs were vegetarian in the beginning (Genesis 1:29–30) – even the T-Rex! (Just because it had big teeth, it doesn't mean he was created carnivorous. Pandas have big teeth too, but eat bamboo; fruit bats have fangs, but eat fruit). You see, the world that God created was "good" and "very good" (Genesis 1:1–31) – there was NO death, NO suffering, NO millions of years of evolution...

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
